The Federal Government entered a partial shutdown at midnight on Friday, December 21, 2018. While some agencies such as the Department of Health and Human Services and the Department of Defense were funded prior to the shutdown and continue to be fully operational, others such as National Science Foundation and NASA, are not funded (see table below). All funding including but not limited to grants, cooperative agreements, contracts and fellowship awards from agencies without FY 2019 appropriations may be impacted.

You should not expect any additional funding to be provided by any closed agency until the Federal Government shutdown has ended.

Based on guidance from OMB, and review of agency specific guidance, we have concluded that, in general, active grant and contract activity funded with FY2019 (or prior year) appropriations <u>can</u> continue to the extent there are funds currently available and the term of the contract, grant or cooperative agreement has not expired.
