The Office of the Vice Provost and Dean of Research is seeking applications for a faculty leadership position: Senior Associate Vice Provost (SAVP) for Research.

This is a fractional appointment, with an expected commitment level in the range of 0.25 to 0.5 FTE. The term of the appointment is 3 years, starting September 2022.

The SAVP for Research will assume leadership responsibilities for research initiatives and opportunities that strengthen collaboration across campus, including between Stanford and SLAC, and with external entities, including private, public, and international organizations. The job responsibilities will focus on development of strategy and management of relationships so as to enhance Stanford's research competitiveness and impact.

Based in the Office of the Vice Provost and Dean of Research (VPDoR), the SAVP for Research will report to the VPDoR. The SAVP will work collaboratively with other leaders involved in research oversight and support within schools (e.g., Senior Associate Deans for Research and for Academic Affairs) and VPDoR (e.g., other Senior Associate Vice Provosts for Research, Senior Associate Dean for Finance and Operations, Executive Director of Technology Licensing), as well as faculty leaders across campus.

- A distinguished track record of leading sponsored projects in science or engineering
- Knowledge of federal research landscape and regulations at a deep level
- Experience or strong interest in technology transfer or translation of research to policy
- Outstanding communication skills
- A strong track record of building and cultivating collaborative relationships within and across organizations
- Excellent judgment, discretion, and initiative in managing projects with diverse stakeholders

- Experience in public-private partnerships
- Demonstrated ability to work with faculty and staff in implementing policies or programs
