

## Senior Associate Vice Provost for Clinical Research Governance April 22, 2022

The Office of the Vice Provost and Dean of Research, in conjunction with the School of Medicine, is seeking applications for a new faculty leadership position: Senior Associate Vice Provost (SAVP) for Clinical Research Governance.

This is a fractional appointment, with an expected commitment level in the range of 0.3 to FTE. The term of the appointment is 3 years.

The SAVP for Clinical Research Governance will assume leadership responsibilities in relation to oversight of the University's large and diverse program of clinical research, much of which Stanford faculty members conduct at Stanford Health Care and Lucile Packard Children's Hospital. The responsibilities will focus on development and coordination of efforts to ensure that the University's clinical research conforms to the highest ethical standards and complies with all applicable regulatory requirements.

Based in the Office of the Vice Provost and Dean of Research (VPDoR), the SAVP for Clinical Research Governance will report jointly to the VPDoR and the Dean of the School of Medicine.

The SAVP for Clinical Research Governance will work collaboratively with other leaders involved in research oversight and support within the School of Medicine (e.g., Senior Associate Dean for Research) and VPDoR (e.g., Associate Vice Provost for Research Policy and Integrity, Director of Research Compliance Office), as well as key hospital leaders (e.g., chief medical officers, chief nursing officers).

## **Essential Qualifications:**

- A faculty appointment in the School of Medicine (University Tenure Line with tenure or University Medical Line with continuing term)
- A clinical appointment (current or recent)
- A distinguished track record of leading clinical research
- Knowledge of federal research regulations and experience working with those regulations in conducting clinical research
- Outstanding communication skills

## **Desirable Qualifications:**

- Experience in leading clinical trials
- Service as a Chair or member of an Institutional Review Board
